### **GRSC6038 HKU Transferable Research Skills Course, Semester 2, 2013 -14 (March 12-15, 2014)**

The Graduate School is offering a residential course **GRSC6038 HKU Transferable Research Skills Course** during the Reading Week of Semester 2. The course is based on the award winning transferable skills programme regularly run at Imperial College London.

#### **Aims**

The primary purpose of the course is to enhance both the personal and research effectiveness of RPG students. The course offers a wonderful opportunity for the development of awareness and skills which are significant for students' postgraduate study, career and whole person development. It also exposes students to a new learning environment where they meet people from different disciplines and cultural backgrounds and have fun.

#### **Course Details**

<b>Date and Time:</b>	March 12 - March 15, 2014 Students will be residing at HKUKC throughout this period.
<b>Accommodation:</b>	The University of Hong Kong - Kadoorie Centre (HKUKC) Lam Kam Road, Shek Kong, Yuen Long, New Territories
<b>Course Fee:</b>	HK\$1,500. The Graduate School and the Faculty will each contribute HK\$650 and the student should pay the rest of HK\$200. Course fee will be collected upon successful admission.
<b>Curriculum:</b>	This is an experiential learning course. An interactive teaching mode is used. Students will be divided into small teams to perform a series of challenging group tasks. Topics covered in the course include but not limited to planning and management of RPG study, creativity, communication skills, group dynamics, collaborative research and developing self-awareness.
<b>No. of Places:</b>	30 students
<b>Record of Study:</b>	Assessment result will be recorded in the transcript upon completion of the course.

<b>Eligibility:</b>	Early stage full-time PhD students or MPhil students about to embark on their PhD studies. Students with global outlook, appreciation of cultural diversity and good English are most welcome.
