Curriculum: The course adopts an interactive teaching mode which focuses on experiential

learning, achieved through a series of challenging group tasks. Participants will be divided into small teams to perform various group exercises. Topics include planning, project management, creativity in research, communication skills, group dynamics, networking, developing self-awareness, collaborative research and careers. As much as possible, links are made to the research environment and participants are

encouraged to apply their new insights to their work.
