Programme Details

Duration: March 13 to 16, 2013 (Wednesday - Saturday)

Students will be residential from March 13 to 15, 2013 and be available for

the whole period including evening activities.

Venue: The University of Hong Kong - Kadoorie Center (HKUKC) at Yuen Long

Curriculum: The course adopts an interactive teaching mode which focuses on

experiential learning, achieved through a series of challenging group tasks. Participants will be divided into small teams to perform various group Topics include planning, project management, creativity, exercises. communication skills, group dynamics, networking, developing selfawareness, collaborative research and careers. As much as possible, links are made to the research environment and participants are encouraged to

apply their new insights to their work.

Accommodation: Students will stay together at HKUKC during the course period. Certification: Record of course completion will be input in student's transcript.
