The Joint Centre for Advanced Study (JCAS)

The Joint Centre for Advanced Study (JCAS) is a joint effort among The University of Hong Kong, The Chinese University of Hong Kong and The Hong Kong University of Science and Technology in developing greater cooperation and deeper collaboration in response to UGC's initiative in the development of strategic alliances and deep collaboration in higher education. The first initiative under this umbrella is the joint offering of courses for research postgraduate students.

Procedures for Application

Students who are interested in taking courses under this scheme should approach the departments of their home institutions for advice and complete the regular procedures of course registration at their home institution. Additionally, they should also complete the student record form and submit it to the Graduate School or the registration office of their home institution. As the authority to enroll on JCAS courses rests with the partner department of the student's own institution, students will not be separately notified by the host institution of the outcome of course registration. Course(s) taken will be included on the student's academic transcript.
